The winning candidate will ensure timely, efficient and contract compliant services are provided to the commercial client while achieving operational and vocational training goals for persons with disabilities. This position offers an exciting and challenging opportunity for a professional seeking to prove their skills.

EMPLOYEE REQUIREMENTS

Experience: Must have five years experience in housekeeping, janitorial, vehicle or facilities maintenance industry. Work history must indicate increasing proficiency in the cleaning and maintenance industry. Military, rehabilitation or vocational training experience is helpful with a proven record of supervising a diverse workforce. The ideal candidate will have one or more cleaning industry certifications. The candidate will be capable of instructing workers on proper cleaning techniques and the efficient use of green chemicals. Must demonstrate excellent verbal and written communications skills. Candidates with a certified long-term or severe disability highly considered.

Special Requirements: Agency's primary mission is providing vocational training, employment and job placement services for persons with significant disabilities who perform 75% of the direct labor required to perform contracted services. The applicant must have a genuine interest in successfully leading and training a workforce which is largely disadvantaged.
